- To undertake additional duties as reasonably requested by the Head and/or Deputy Head of Bexley Music



- To plan and organise sessions, as appropriate to the ensemble/students
- To prepare the ensemble for internal and external performances
- To liaise with the Ensemble Assistant (where appropriate) on matters relating to the effective running of the ensemble
- Where appropriate, to utilise the skills of the Ensemble Assistant and provide training opportunities within rehearsals
- To select, adapt and arrange music for the needs of the ensemble/individuals
- To tailor teaching and conducting methods to the needs of the ensemble/individuals
- To provide an appropriate range of activities within rehearsals to further the students' musical and technical abilities

- To direct the ensemble and participate in Bexley Music concerts, performances and music tours (if required)
- To liaise with parents where appropriate
